TITLE: Poweshiek County Precinct Boundaries

PURPOSE: An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 7 which set the Precinct Boundaries for the County of Poweshick, Iowa.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Poweshick County Board of Supervisors, Poweshick County, Iowa:

Section 1. Amendment. That Ordinance No. 7 adopted by the Poweshick County Board of Supervisors on September 24, 2001, be amended by correcting the following Precinct No 8 description:

Precinct No. 8 - All of the area of the city of Grinnell, which is encompassed by a line which begins at the intersection of the centerline of Sixth Avenue and the west city limits, and then extends east along the centerline of Sixth Avenue to the centerline of Prairie Street, then south along the centerline of Prairie Street to Fifth Avenue, then east along the centerline of Fifth Avenue to Pearl Street, the north along the centerline of Pearl Street to Sixth Avenue, then east along the centerline of Sixth Avenue to East Street, then south along the centerline of East Street to Fourth Avenue, then west along the centerline of Fourth Avenue to Broad Street, then south along the centerline of Broad Street to the north right of way line of the Iowa Interstate Railroad tracks, then easterly along the north right-of-way line of the Iowa Interstate Railroad right-of-way to its intersection with the west right-of-way line of the Union Pacific Railroad then southerly along said west right-of-way line of the Union Pacific Railroad to its first point of intersection with the city limits, then continuing on along the city limits in a clockwise direction to the point of beginning, shall constitute Third Ward Precinct. According to the 2000 census figures, this precinct is comprised of 2,249 residents. The Polling Place is the Grinnell Community Center, Grinnell, IA.

Section 2. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability Clause. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4. When Effective. This amendment shall be in effect January 15, 2002, after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
