Board met in regular session at 8:30 a.m. at Drake Library, Grinnell, Iowa. Members present Diana Dawley, Merle Doty & Jason Roudabush.

Chairman Roudabush led the pledge of allegiance.

Moved by Dawley, 2nd by Doty to approve agenda as amended to include approval of Utility Permit #20-29U. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Moved by Doty, 2nd by Dawley to approve February 27 & March 2, 2020 board minutes. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

8:30 a.m. Faith Repp & Jill Robinson with Capstone met with board to discuss the jail diversion program. The jail diversion program provides case management to individuals who are in contact with the criminal justice system because of a mental health or co-occurring disorder and such participation is voluntary.

Moved by Dawley, 2nd by Doty to approve March 6, 2020 Poweshiek County Payroll for \$194,774.61. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Moved by Doty, 2nd by Dawley to approve Certificate of Appointment for Christopher Pankow, Park Technician, Conservation effective March 9, 2020 with rate of pay \$39,000 per year. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Moved by Dawley, 2nd by Doty to approve Utility Permit #20-29U to Lynnville Telephone Company for work in Sugar Creek Township. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Board discussed a possible ATV/UTV ordinance allowing for the use of ATV/UTV on gravel or dirt county roadways. Roudabush stated he contacted surrounding counties of Mahaska, Iowa & Jasper, who have similar ordinances in effect, and those counties stated they did not have any issues with the ordinance allowing individuals to ride ATV/UTV on rural county roads. The board stated to have the county attorney review the draft ordinance and to place on the board's agenda again for discussion.
