The Poweshiek County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30 a.m. Members present: Jeff Tindle, Jacki Bolen, and Jason Roudabush.

Moved by Bolen, 2nd by Tindle to approve agenda. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Moved by Tindle, 2nd by Bolen to approve January 15, 2026, board minutes. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Moved by Bolen, 2nd by Tindle to approve Letter of Agreement between PPME, Secondary Road Union, and Poweshiek County to amend, under Article 13, a normal workweek from five 8-hour days to four 10-hour days, for the period of June 1 to September 4. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Jennifer Anderson, Treasurer, met with the board to discuss the possible abatement of taxes on a county-held mobile home. Anderson stated that the mobile home was located in Grinnell and that she received an email from the manager of the mobile home park requesting a junking certificate because they had removed the mobile home and scrapped it. Anderson stated she cannot issue a junking certificate when taxes are outstanding, and she inquired if the Board of Supervisors would agree to abate the taxes owed, which is currently \$937. Board was not comfortable abating the taxes and asked Anderson to reach out to the mobile home park owners, requesting payment of the back taxes before the process of issuing a junking certificate could be started.

Brooke Holder & Kristy Reedy, Public Health, met with the board to present the proposed FY27 budget for public health pass-through grants and funding contract with the county.

Bart Klaver, County Attorney, met with the board to present the proposed FY27 county attorney budget.

Missy Eilander, Auditor, presented the proposed FY27 budget for the auditor, elections, and local elections.

Moved by Tindle, 2nd by Bolen to authorize Missy Eilander, Auditor, to sign necessary documents relating to the county's property liability insurance for the calendar year 2026. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Board of Supervisors are attending the Assessor Conference Board meeting tomorrow.

Bolen is attending Veterans Day on the Hill at the State Capitol on Wednesday and is also attending the Montezuma School Board meeting this week.

Tindle is attending the EMA FY27 budget meeting on Wednesday.

Moved by Bolen, 2nd by Tindle at 11:05 a.m. to adjourn.
