The Poweshiek County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30 a.m. Members present: Jeff Tindle, Jacki Bolen, and Jason Roudabush.

Moved by Bolen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tindle to approve agenda. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Moved by Tindle, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bolen to approve January 26, 2026, board minutes. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Matt Maschmann, Sheriff, and Steve Kivi, Chief Deputy Sheriff, met with the board to present the proposed FY27 budget for the Sheriff's Office and Adult Corrections.

9:00 a.m. Moved by Tindle, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bolen to enter into public hearing on FY27 budget amendment. Present: Jason Roudabush, Jacki Bolen, Jeff Tindle, Supervisors; Missy Eilander, Auditor; Steve Kivi, Chief Deputy Sheriff; and Matt Maschmann, Sheriff. Moved by Tindle, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bolen to approve Iowa DOT agreement to perform work within the State Highway ROW to Asplundh Tree Expert LLC for work in Sugar Creek and Washington Townships, along Hwy 146 North of Searsboro. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Auditor Eilander stated the terms for three members of the zoning commission, Rick Swanson, Tom Ryan, and Kirk Berry, were set to expire. Auditor Eilander spoke with Zoning Administrator JD Griffith, and Griffith advised Tom Ryan and Kirk Berry agreed to serve another 5-year term, but Rick Swanson did not want to serve. Griffith would recommend appointing Zach VanArkel and re-appointing Tom Ryan and Kirk Berry.

Moved by Bolen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tindle to re-appoint Tom Ryan and Kirk Berry to the Zoning Commission for a 5-year term. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Moved by Tindle, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bolen to appoint Zach VanArkel to the Zoning Commission for a 5-year term. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Bolen provided an update from her Region 6 meeting. Bolen stated discussion at this meeting involved suggestions to increase transportation rates and increase requested per capita funding request from counties due to Region 6 receiving less state and federal funding.

Tindle stated he has a Middle Iowa Watershed meeting today.

Moved by Bolen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tindle at 11:24 a.m. to adjourn.
