The Poweshiek County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30 a.m. Members present: Jeff Tindle, Jacki Bolen, and Jason Roudabush.

Moved by Tindle, 2nd by Bolen to approve agenda. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Moved by Bolen, 2nd by Tindle to approve February 26, 2026 board minutes. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Matt Maschmann, Sheriff, and Galyn Nook, IT Director, met with the board to discuss replacing the UPS at the sheriff's office/dispatch center. The UPS is original with the building, and it is a vital part for the continuity of operations at the public safety building in case of power outages. The UPS is a battery backup for when electricity is not available. Nook obtained various quotes for the replacement of the UPS, and the lowest bid came in around \$59,000.

Moved by Tindle, 2nd by Bolen to authorize bids for bridge materials for the replacement of two bridges in Sections 32 & 33, Scott Township, located on 160th Street and 475th Avenue. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Moved by Bolen, 2nd by Tindle to approve the revision to the Construction Program to include 100th Street projects. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Moved by Bolen, 2nd by Roudabush to authorize bids for the 100th Street grading project. Roudabush – aye; Bolen – aye; Tindle – abstained. Motion carried.

Board held FY27 budget workshop.

Moved by Tindle, 2nd by Bolen at 12:41 p.m. to adjourn.
