The Poweshiek County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30 a.m. Members present: Jacki Bolen and Jason Roudabush.

Moved by Bolen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Roudabush to approve agenda. 2 ayes. Motion carried.

Moved by Bolen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Roudabush to approve June 22, 2026, board minutes. 2 ayes. Motion carried.

Galyn Nook, IT Director, met with board to give an update on projects that have been happening within the county.

Andrew Wittmus & Susan Allen, Globe Life/Liberty National, met with board to discuss policies they would like to offer to employees. Board asked them to email prices for policies to the Auditor so they could be compared with what is already offered to employees.

Lyle Brehm, Engineer, presented bid information for the bridge replacement project NE of Ewart on 100<sup>th</sup> Street in Section 15, Pleasant Township. Bids were received in Ames on June 16, and the low bid was from PCI for \$1,299,521.21. Payment will be made through the Auditor's Office, but the project cost will be reimbursed to the county by federal funding. Brehm recommends the Board of Supervisors award the project to PCI and direct Auditor Eilander to sign the contract documents on behalf of the County upon their return.

Moved by Bolen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Roudabush to award Pleasant 15 bridge project BROS-CO79(73)--8J-79 to PCI for \$1,299,521.21 and authorize Auditor Eilander to sign contract documents on behalf of the County. 2 ayes. Motion carried.

Brehm updated the Board on Secondary Road projects happening around the County.
