RESOLUTION TO ENDORSE TSIP GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, Iowa Code Section 312.2 (11) allocates "...one-half of one percent of moneys credited to the road use tax fund..." for traffic safety improvement projects, and

WHEREAS, the Iowa Department of Transportation manages and directs these funds through their Traffic Safety Improvement Program (TSIP), and

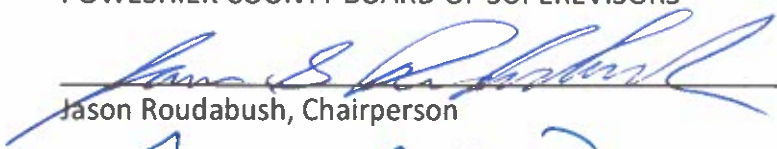
WHEREAS, the TSIP program allows for the usage of funds towards traffic control devices, and

WHEREAS, the Brooklyn-Guernsey-Malcom Community School District is interested in improving the pedestrian crossing on Highway V18 at the entrance to their Junior/Senior High School which serves several students in Brooklyn,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Poweshiek County Board of Supervisors endorses an application to the TSIP program for signing to improve the pedestrian crossing of V18 near North Street in Brooklyn. The Board understands and agrees that Poweshiek County will be responsible for maintenance of the improvement.
