## RESOLUTION #2023-1 RESOLUTION FOR ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT

WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Iowa Code Sections 321.255 and 321.285 to determine the speed limit of any secondary road is greater than is reasonable and proper under the conditions existing, and may determine and declare a reasonable and proper speed limit, and

WHEREAS the current closure of F62 between 18<sup>th</sup> Street and 35<sup>th</sup> Street for the replacement of a bridge on F62 has caused increased traffic on rock roads in this area,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the speed limit is established effective immediately and terminating upon the reopening of F62 between 18<sup>th</sup> Street and 35<sup>th</sup> Street, and appropriate signs shall be erected at the location described as follows;

35 mph on E 160<sup>th</sup> Street commencing at F62 and proceeding north to 490<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

35 mph on 490<sup>th</sup> Avenue commencing at E 160<sup>th</sup> Street and proceeding east to IA146.

35 mph on 515<sup>th</sup> Avenue commencing at the Jasper/Poweshiek County line and proceeding east to 35<sup>th</sup> Street.

35 mph on 35<sup>th</sup> Street commencing at 515<sup>th</sup> Avenue and proceeding north to F62.
